Maria Santiago-Valentín is a Learning Disabilities Consultant since 2014, Mindfulness Educator, Applied Behavior Analysis Technician, and case manager. María has expanded her role in her community as organizer and leader in the conservation and protection of our planet. In her town she is an alternate member of Clark Environmental Commission. She is the founder of the Global Awareness Project for Climate Justice and contributing author of Climate Abandoned, an anthology edited and compiled by the author Jill Cody. Maria wrote the Climate Crisis and Education chapter. She is the Founder/President of the non-profit NJ & NY Awareness Project for Climate Justice, Inc.
